900 g milk 3.5%	31.75oz
0.9 g tonka beans	0.03oz
180 g Maracaibo Clasificado 65%, Dark chocolate couverture, Grated	6.35oz

Bring the milk to a boil, stir in the grated tonka bean. Add Maracaibo Clasificado 65%, grated and stir until dissolved. Mix in a Rotor mixer until a foam forms (approx. 30 seconds).
